Important Oasis Rules:

- During the winter term we will be staying indoors. While at the youth group, no one should go beyond the car park or in front of the church as that would disturb the local residents. Please keep the noise down while in the car park, no kicking of balls and please do not touch any of the cars.
- No one should leave the chapel site during Oasis, unless they are going home and have made one of the leaders aware, because they are in "loco parentis". That includes going to a local shop.
- No smoking, alcohol or illegal substances are allowed at club. It is not allowed on Meadow Way Chapel property.
- Everyone who attends Oasis youth group must have a signed consent form so that if there are any problems or accidents there is the information to cope with it.
